Conference Incentive Awards \$500-\$700 to attend GCEA Conference

GCEA will award a number of grants, from a minimum of \$500 to a maximum of \$700, to educators who are members of the Association to assist them in participating in their first GCEA Annual Conference. The amount of the award will be determined by the distance the participant will have to travel to attend the annual conference.

The enclosed map details the five travel zones that will be used to determine the amount of the grant. Study the travel zone map carefully and record in the application in which zone you reside. The travel zones will vary from year to year based upon the geographical location of the annual conference. This year the 97th Annual GCEA Conference will be held July 24 – 28, 2022 in Boone, NC.

Purpose

The GCEA Annual Conference Incentive Awards Program (IAP) is designed to offer an inducement to members to attend their first GCEA Annual Conference. By encouraging and assisting members to attend their first annual conference, more members will become better acquainted with the benefits of active participation in the work of the Association.

The GCEA Annual Conference is a unique event, the fact that it is held during the summer, usually on a college campus, and the diversity of educators who attend and participate all combine to make this annual conference a most beneficial affair.

Eligibility

Anyone teaching Graphic Arts, Graphic or Visual Communications, Graphic Design, Graphic Imaging, Graphic Media, Web Media, or Printing is eligible to apply for the IAP. These grants have been awarded to teachers from junior or senior high school, post-secondary schools, community or technical colleges, and four year colleges and universities. To accept an award, if selected by the IAP Committee, the applicant must be under contract for full-time teaching for the coming school year.

Incentive Award candidates must be paid-up members of GCEA. If the applicant is not a current paid-up member, the GCEA Membership Application can be found and completed online at www.GCEAonline.org.

Any person who has previously participated in an on site GCEA/IGAEA Annual Conference as a regular dues-paying member of GCEA/IGAEA is not eligible for an Incentive Award.

If you have participated in an annual conference, please pass this material on to an educator who has not previously attended an GCEA/IGAEA annual conference.

Limited funding this year will reduce the number of awards for this year. Please apply by deadline to be considered.

January I — Application review opens

July I — Closing date for application review

Selection begins now and award recipients will be notified ASAP

Selection

The IAP Committee solicits applications, reviews all completed applications, and selects recipients for each of the Incentive Awards available. If the applicant pool is large enough, an equal number of alternates is selected and placed in priority order to be used when selected awardees cannot attend.

Awards will be granted on the basis of information supplied by the candidate on the attached application.

IAP awardees and alternates will be notified by May 10, 2020 as to their status by GCEA pending membership verification. Awardees will be given 5 days to indicate their acceptance of the award. In the event that an Incentive Award can not be accepted by an awardee, alternates will be named up to July 1, 2022.

IAP grants will be paid only to those who register for, pay total conference fees, and participate in the complete 95th GCEA Annual Conference (July 24 – 28, 2020) being held at Appalachian State University in Boone, North Carolina.

Recognition of Awardees

Recognition of individuals receiving GCEA Conference Incentive Awards will take place during the annual conference banquet. Awards will be transferred to recepient's account after the conference is completed.

History of the Incentive Awards Program


- 1976 IGAEA Conference at Glassboro State College, hosted by Paul Von Holtz.
- 1977 IAP approved by the membership, IGAEA Conference at Ferris State College.
- 1978 IAP started with interest gained on earnings from 1976 conference. First Conference Incentive Awards were given to four conference attendees, at Central Missouri State University.

1978 - 2019

Additional conference earnings have been added since then and interest income has allowed GCEA to increase the number of and amount of these awards. Over the thirty-seven annual conferences (1978 – 2017) that the Incentive Awards have been granted, in excess of \$75,000 of earned interest income and donations has been distributed to over 260 individuals. These awardees have traveled to the 37 annual conference sites from 39 states in the U.S.A. Three came from Ontario and three from Alberta in Canada. Ten came from England and two from Wales in the UK, one from Germany, one from Belgium, and one from Taiwan, Republic of China, to participate in their first GCEA annual conference.

- 1997 Conference Incentive Awards were renamed in honor of Paul D.Von Holtz who chaired this committee since its inception until his death in 1998.
- 2014 IGAEA changes its name to Graphic Communications Education Association (GCEA).
